The daily routine of the incubator necessary for successful hatching is: the checking water level for the maintaining of required humidity,

temperature and rotation of eggs. Approximate hatching date is 27 September. The chicks will be taken back to Miss Skye's to grow out. **NB:** Did you know a hen rotates her eggs every 3 hours – *busy, busy!*
