To ensure students' safety, the following practices apply:

- Jewellery is not permitted at school apart from watches, medical alert information, sleepers or stud earrings and items of religious significance, which should be protected under clothing.

- All students are expected and encouraged to dress in school uniform. If this creates difficulties for families, please contact the school for support.

The Ballimore Public School uniform is available for purchase from the Ballimore P&C. Uniform prices are set by the P&C, reviewed on a yearly basis. Uniforms, new and used (in the form of a Clothing Pool) are kept in a cupboard within of the Administration Office Building.

A School Uniform Price List is to be provided to the school and displayed with uniforms for ease of purchase during school/office hours.
